Research Supplies Fee Allocation for PhD Students in
Doctor of Philosophy in Environment and Resource Studies
(International Program)

The Faculty of Environment and Resource Studies at Mahidol University offers a Research Supplies Fee Allocation in order to support students in Doctor of Philosophy in Environment and Resource Studies Program in conducting quality doctoral researches. The details are as follows.

### 1. Objective

To support students in the Doctor of Philosophy in Environment and Resource Studies Program to conduct quality doctoral researches.

#### 2. Allocation

Doctor of Philosophy in Environment and Resource Studies Program

Committee agree to provide 100,000 baht, which will be paid directly to students and will be divided into three instalments as follows.

- $1^{st}$ : 50% will be paid after proposal defence.
- $2^{\text{nd}}$ : 30% will be paid before data collection.
- $3^{rd}$ : 20% will be paid after thesis defence.

## 3. Eligibility

- 3.1 Student who passes his/her proposal defence within semester 3 after starting the study.
- 3.2 Student who has enrolled as a student since Academic Year 2015.

### 4. Required Documents

 $\underline{1}^{\text{st}}$  time: 50% - after proposal defence. Students are required to submit;

- A hard copy of Evaluation of the Thesis/Thematic Paper Proposal Examination form that shows a 'passed' result or a result of a Revision of Thesis/Thematic Paper Proposal Examination form.

 $2^{nd}$  time: 30% - before data collection. Students are required to submit;

- A hard copy of recommendation letter from a major advisor to certify that the student is ready to collect data
- A hard copy of Thesis title and Thesis Advisory Committee form/Thematic Paper Title and Thematic Paper Advisory Committee form  $\underline{3}^{rd}$  time: 20% after thesis defence, students are required to submit;
- A hard copy of Evaluation of the Oral Thesis/Thematic Paper Defence or result of a Revision of Thesis/Thematic Paper form (if any)

#### 5. Term & Condition

If student could not graduate, student would be required to refund all received allocation without any interest.

The decision by the program committee is final.
